◇Yamaguchi University: A brief description

Yamaguchi University was established as a national university in 1949. The University is now a large institution with seven Faculties, nine Graduate Schools. It has a teaching staff of 1,016 which includes 343 full professors.

We currently have 325 overseas students from around 28 countries studying alongside 8,967 students from Japan.

In the past five years, 5 students participated in the "Japanese Studies" Program at Yamaguchi University (three students from Australia, one from Ukraine, one from the UK).



◇Japanese Studies Program

1. Aims and Contents of the Course in brief

The course aims primarily at giving the students' a firm grasp of basic Japanese and giving their speaking, listening, reading, and writing capabilities.

The Course includes intermediate Japanese language and culture classes.

4. Subjects Offered to the Japanese Studies Program students

•Japanese Seminar A

The main focus is on listening and speaking. The student reads newspaper articles written in simple Japanese.

•Japanese Seminar B

The main focus is on syntax. After discussion, the student will write on the topic discussed.

•Japanese Seminar C

The main focus is on extensive reading. The student will read newspaper articles, essays, novels, etc.
