



Development of Total *Installed Wind Power Capacity

Wind power is one of the most important natural energy resources in the world, and many countries are interested in using it. According to data on global wind power development, installed wind power capacity is growing rapidly. In 1996, the total installed wind power capacity in the world was only 6, 100 MW. By 2010, however, the capacity had increased to 197, 039 MW. One of the reasons for this rapid growth could be that quite a few countries are struggling with serious environmental issues, such as improving air quality and reducing the amount of CO_2 to fight against climate change.

The graph above shows the development of total installed wind power capacity in six different countries. In 2006, Germany had the largest wind power capacity, but growth was slow after that. On the other hand, development in the US was so rapid that it became the country with the largest installed wind power capacity in 2008. Another country which achieved rapid development is China. In 2006, it had the fewest windmills, but it became the country with the largest installed wind power capacity in 2010. That year, China had nearly 45, 000 MW of wind power capacity, which made up 22. 7% of the world total, followed by the US at 20. 4%. Spain was the second leading country in 2006, sharing second place with 15. 6% of the world total. However, it was only the fourth largest in 2010 with 20, 676 MW of wind power capacity.

According to more recent data on installed wind power capacity from January to December in 2011, the leading country, China, reached 26.2% of the world total. India was still fifth, but its capacity was growing more rapidly than that of many other countries. As the technology gradually becomes less expensive, it is likely that more countries will install more windmills.
