

At the beginning of the 2016 school year, English teachers at Hoshiyama High School started a new program for students who were having difficulties in English. To begin with, English teachers carried out a survey to find out what problems they had.

The teachers asked two hundred students in the second year what they thought the most difficult English skill was: listening, reading, speaking or writing. The results clearly showed that more than half of the students found speaking was the most difficult. Listening came next, and reading followed. Because students seemed to have problems with oral communication skills, the teachers decided to start a new extracurricular program called "English Exploration." The new program was designed to give students more chances to communicate with others in English. It also offered a chance for students to win prizes by using English outside of regular classes.

The English Exploration program included two activities. One was an interview competition, and the other was an English Speaking Society (ESS) club after school. For the interview competition, students had to ask English teachers questions in English during break times, lunch time, and after school. Every time they asked a question, they got a stamp on their score sheets. Students were also able to take part in ESS club meetings, which were held twice a week after school on Mondays and Thursdays. When students attended an ESS club meeting, they got three stamps. Students submitted their score sheets each Friday, and the student who received the most stamps that week got a prize the following Monday. As the teachers had hoped, the number of students who took part in the activities and submitted their score sheets increased each week.
