The World Health Organization (WHO) is part of the United Nations. It works to improve health all over the world. The WHO does everything it can to fight diseases such as HIV/AIDS, but it also tries to help people to lead healthier lifestyles. The WHO gives advice on exercising and healthy eating, for example. People around the world use this advice to try to live healthier lives.

The International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC) belongs to the WHO. There are many types of cancer and also many causes of cancer. The IARC looks at research into the causes of cancer in order to give advice to people. This is a difficult job, however, because some things clearly cause cancer and some things only *might* cause cancer. The IARC's job is to make lists of these things. The table above shows only three of the five groups in the full list. Group 1 contains things that cause cancer in humans. Group 2A contains things that probably cause cancer in humans. The IARC is able to say this because the things in Group 2A are known to cause cancer in animals, and therefore, they also probably cause cancer in humans. Group 2B contains things that possibly cause cancer in humans, because these things sometimes cause cancer in animals.

It may not be necessary to avoid everything on the list. The list shows things that have a link to cancer, or things that might have a link to cancer. It does not tell us if the risk is big or small. It is well known, for example, that smoking is dangerous and is connected to lung cancer as well as other types of cancer. If you smoke, your chances of getting cancer are much higher. We cannot say that sunshine and bacon are equal to smoking in their level of danger, but the IARC says that we should be careful with the things on the list to reduce our risk of getting cancer.
