



Mr. Brown: Oh, you mean "blind soccer?" I watched it, too. They could play very well.

Ken: How can they do that? They can't see the ball and other players, right? I couldn't understand the rules, either.

Mr. Brown: Then, why don't you look it up on the Internet?

Ken: Sure.

"The Blind Soccer"

Blind Soccer started in the 1980s and was played in Europe or South America first. In Japan, the international rules were introduced in 2001, and more and more people have started playing it since then. It is a sport like soccer, but there are some differences.

First, except for the goal keepers, players wear eye masks so they cannot see the ball at all. One team has five players. Second, a special ball is used. It makes a sound while it is rolling. So players must listen carefully for the sound to play well. Third, to keep the game fair and safe, players have to say "Voy" and then they attack the player with the ball on the other team. "Voy" means "Go."

Blind soccer is popular around the world. Blind soccer players can take part in the Paralympic Games. Some players practice very hard to improve their skills for that. You may be surprised by how well they play with their team members. The international games are as exciting as 11-a-side soccer games.

One of the goals of the sport is to make a friendly society for all people. By playing blind soccer games, people get to know how to communicate with others and they can become good friends. So the games are used to build a strong sense of teamwork in some schools and companies. Finally people can realize that every person is as important to his or her society as every player is to his or her team.

It is one of the events in the Tokyo Paralympic Games in 2020. Don't miss the chance to see it!!

Ken: I didn't know about it at all. I can understand how they play it now. Also, I learned blind soccer wasn't just played for fun.

Mr. Brown: You're right. Some companies use this game for new workers every year, too. There are other sports that all people, regardless of age, gender or physical condition, can play together. We call them universal sports.

Mr. Brown: That's right. Oh, the next blind soccer game will be held next Sunday. Do you want to go and watch it?


