[6 Holding Status of Facilities]

- ♦ <u>Approximately 95%</u> of the organizations and institutions have permanent facilities.
- ♦ Among the organizations and institutions that have permanent facilities, <u>approximately 30%</u> own them themselves, <u>approximately 10%</u> rent public facilities, and <u>approximately 60%</u> rent private facilities.
