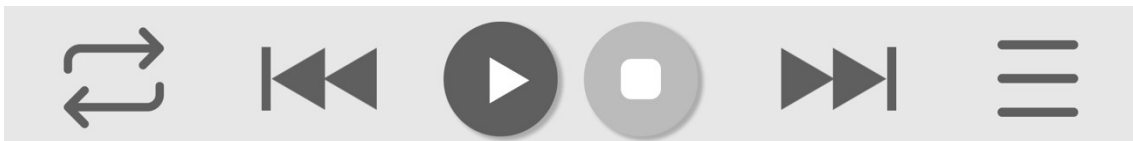
Liam : Look at this graph. It shows which apps are popular.

Liam : I can understand that. Actually, I almost got addicted to games before I came to Japan.

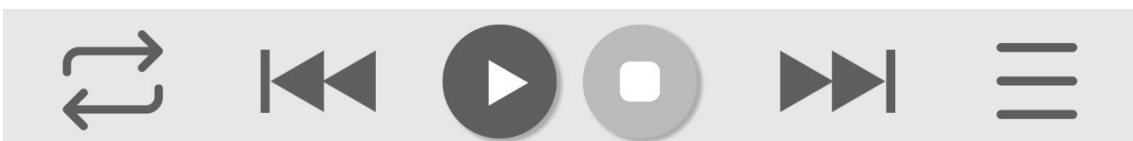
Yuto : The more you play, the more addicted you become. I recently tried a new game, and it's almost impossible to stop playing it.

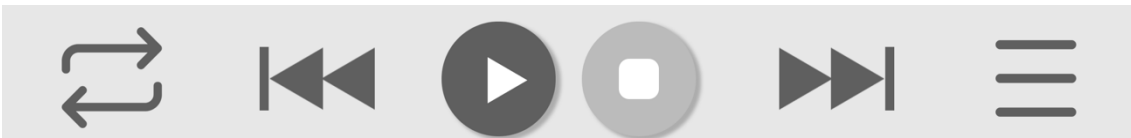
## 語尾の s の発音
