1. 編修の基本方針

この教科書を通して、多文化共生時代を生きるために求められる生徒一人ひとりの「たくましさ」と「しなやかさ」を育てることを編修の基本方針としました。

たくましさ：自分で考え、判断し、行動する力（自己表現力）

しなやかさ：異なるものとの向き合い、協働を通してさまざまな問題を乗り越える力（対話力）

本教科書では、①「知識・技能」②「思考力・判断力・表現力」③「主体的かつ対話的に学習に取り組む態度」の3つの観点を通して、「たくましさ」と「しなやかさ」という2つの資質を育てることができるよう工夫しました。

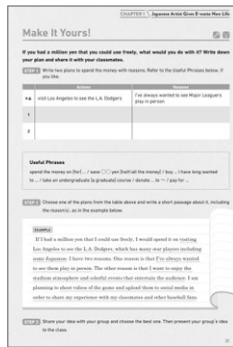
①「知識・技能」の観点（第1号）

- ・英語表現するための語彙力、文法力、慣用表現力を育てる。
- ・英語の言語資源を使って、さまざまなタスクを行う力を育てる。
- ・英語でのアウトプット（スピーキングとライティング）とインプット（リスニングとリーディング）のためのスキルを鍛える。

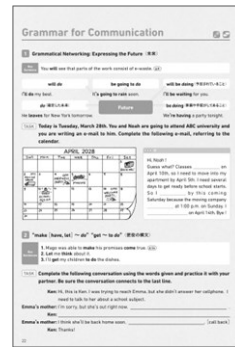

3. 上記の記載事項以外に特に意を用いた点や特色

① 高校での英語学習のサポート

- ・小学校・中学校との接続を円滑にするために、文構造・文法事項については中学校までに学習したものについても取り上げました。
- ・本文横の新語のうち、ぜひ覚えておきたい重要なものを太字にし、チェックマークを付けました。また、イディオムの例文を巻末の **Idiom Sentences** に掲載しました。
- ・正課に入る前に、「単語を関連づけて学ぼう」というコーナーを設けました。具体的な場面を設定し、効果的な学習方法を学びます。
- ・巻末に **Skills for Presentation [Debate-in-Discussion, Outlining]** のコーナーを設けました。活動を通して各スキルの定着を図ります。

② 主体的な学びのための工夫

- ・新語・イディオムと本文の音声を教科書の二次元コードを通して利用できるようにしました。教科書の音声をいつでも聞くことができます。
- ・題材に関連する動画は、二次元コードを通じて視聴できます。題材で取り上げた人物のインタビューや風景などを通じて、本文をより深く理解することができます。
- ・FYI のコーナーでは、題材の背景知識や発展情報を解説し、主体的な学びを促進する工夫を取り入れました。
- ・巻末に「**Expressions for Writing, Discussion, and Debate**」のコーナーを設け、ライティング、ディスカッション、ディベートに必要な表現をまとめました。

③ 題材の選定

- ・題材の選定にあたっては、性別や人種、特定の世界観や宗教に偏らないように努めました。また、国際貢献、技術、食、生き方、観光、スマートフォン、データ科学、心理学、言語・文化、環境、教育、芸術・歴史など、さまざまな分野から選び、学習者の興味・関心を広げることができるように配慮しました。
- ・題材の形式については、説明文、エッセイ、対話文、プレゼンテーション、物語文、スピーチなどを取り入れ、さまざまな形式の英文に触れることができるようにしました。さらに説明文はインターネット記事、雑誌記事、パンフレット、入門書、評論などの具体的な場面を設定し、オーセンティックな英文になるよう心がけました。

④ 環境への配慮

- ・管理された森林資源を使用するなど、再生可能で環境にやさしい原料や製法で作られた用紙を使用しています。
- ・植物由来の油、およびそれらを主体とした廃食用油等をリサイクルした再生油を含んだ植物油インキを使用しています。

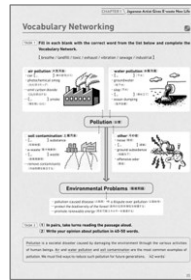
①高等学校外国語科の目標を実現するための工夫

⇒ 「コミュニケーションを行う目的や場面, 状況など」を実現するために, 対話形式の話題を取り入れるとともに, 説明文にも具体的な場面を設定しました。また, 話題については, 日常のおよび社会的なテーマを幅広く扱い, 学習者の興味・関心を広げるよう工夫しました。

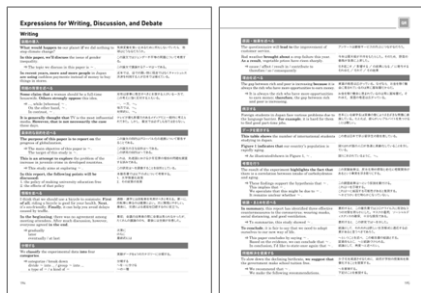

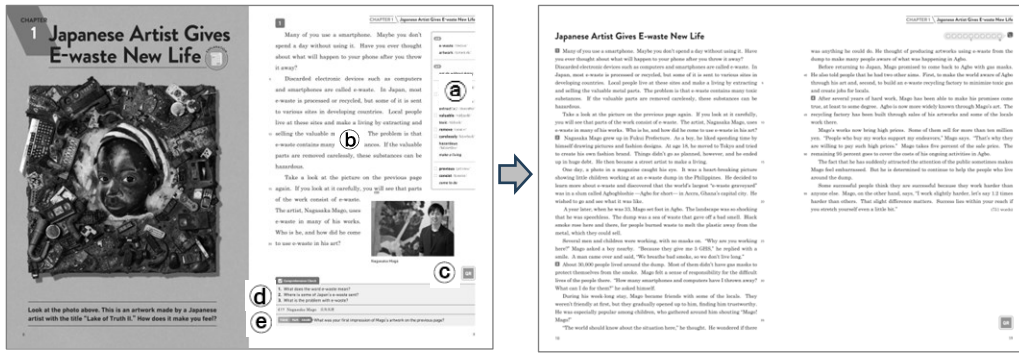

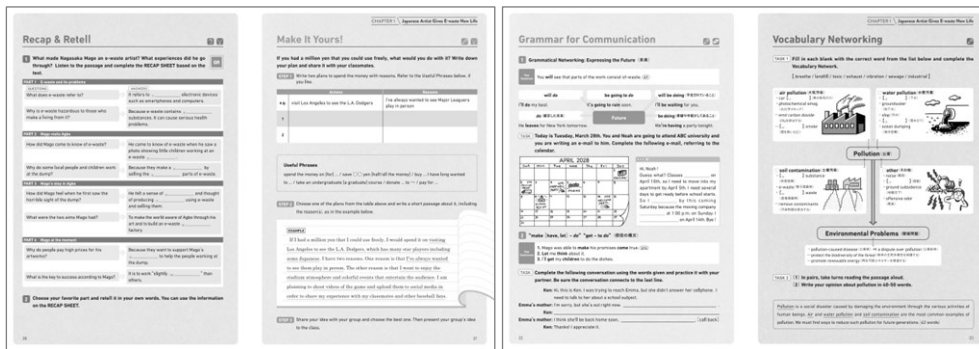

- 実際の音に近づけるために、/ɨ/ /ɯ/を導入し、/i/ /u/と区別した。（/ɨ/は日本語の「イ」と「エ」のほぼ中間の音。/ɯ/は日本語の「ウ」と「オ」のほぼ中間の音）
- 基本的に米音の発音記号および音声を収録したが、さまざまな英語に触れる機会を設けるために、CHAPTER 4については英音の発音記号を掲載した。また、音声の収録に関してもオーストラリア人ナレーターに依頼した。

Have you ever wondered when and how the stationery products we use every day were developed? If you look closely at the stationery products you have, you will notice that many of them are made in Japan. There are also products that were originally invented overseas and further developed in Japan.

Take the stapleless stapler, for example. It is said that the regular stapler was invented in France in the 18th century. Over time, stationery companies tried to develop a stapleless stapler, but it proved to be extremely difficult. In 2009, a major Japanese stationery company released a new user-friendly stapleless model. When documents bound without staples were distributed to the delegates at the IMF/World Bank Annual Meetings in Tokyo in 2012, the delegates were impressed and attention was focused on the new product. They realized that the new type of stapler did not require reloading and was economical and

environmentally friendly.
