

(Joel is a junior high school student from Canada. One week has passed since he came to Japan. Kenji is one of his classmates.)

Kenji : Hi, Joel. How was your first week in Japan?

Joel : Very nice, and I want to know more about this town. Can you show me around the town?

Kenji : OK. Let's go.

(Now they are at a crossing.)

Joel : When I'm at a crosswalk, I often hear this sound from traffic lights. What is it?

Kenji : Oh, it's for blind people. The sound tells them they can go.

Joel : I see. But I can hear two different sounds.

What's the difference?

Kenji: When we go straight on this crosswalk, we can hear one sound. When we walk across that crosswalk, we can hear another sound.

That crosswalk

Joel : So each sound tells the directions.

Kenji : Yes. These two sounds are bird songs, but at some crossings, we can hear music, not bird songs.

Joel : That's interesting! In my town in Canada, there are no such sounds. I've been to some other countries, but I've never heard such sounds at crosswalks.

I think these are very helpful to blind people.

Kenji : Do you think so? Look. We also have these special blocks for blind people on the street.

Joel : Yes, I know that. The color is different but we have such blocks in my town. You can see these blocks near crosswalks or dead ends. Blind people can go along these stripes, and the dots mean "Stop" or "Be careful." The blocks were invented by a Japanese, right?

Kenji : Really? I didn't know that.

Joel : They are used in many countries like Korea, America, Australia and so on.

Kenji : That's great! Now I'm more proud of my country.
