This is a career education program that helps foster children's ability to create their own futures by experiencing an actual job, utilizing tools used by ANA Group employees in their own work.




Blind soccer
– Let's think making the future with others!





Target Groups

Experiencing playing blind soccer and centering on the theme of "diversity," this is a program for building inclusive societies and ensuring "Offering kind-hearted skies for everyone" in 2020 and beyond.





Features of “Building the Future”

1 Program officially recognized by Tokyo 2020 Olympics (education)
