With Kake educational institution's educational agreements with 70 education institutions in 18 countries, Kurashiki University of Science and the Arts is seeking to enhance its education and scholarship worldwide. ② Under the small-group instruction, students can develop their Japanese proficiency with review of basic Japanese grammar they have already learned. ③They will have chances to learn Japanese culture outside school and to mingle with native Japanese inside and outside school. ④ Staff members give students advice on procedures concerning their immigration and stay in Japan, daily life, future plans and so on. ⑤ In principle, all students are supposed to take the Japanese Language Proficiency Test in July and December. Then the IJLP can help them apply and prepare for the tests. ⑥ Students may use college facilities: library, cafeteria, skating rink, gym and so on. ⑦Visa status is "Study Visa" (College Student).
