

Takuya: I was playing soccer with my friends yesterday, but it suddenly started raining.

Mr. Ford: That's too bad. But you can enjoy soccer inside your house.

Takuya: Inside my house? Is that true?

Mr. Ford: Yes. We can enjoy playing soccer on the Internet. It's exciting!

Takuya: I like both playing and watching soccer, but I'm not good at playing computer games. It is different from playing sports.

Mr. Ford: Do you think so? In my country, there are three kinds of sports, physical sports, mind sports and electronic sports. They're all sports. Playing computer games on the Internet is a kind of electronic sports. It is called e-Sports.
