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

Popularity of each restaurant



Satoru is a student at Mitsuba High School. He and his classmates will graduate from high school next month. He is planning to organize a graduation party with his classmates before they go off to different colleges or start working. He collected basic information about restaurants in the area, such as the types of food, prices, and the distance between the restaurant and the closest station to their school. Then, he made a survey. He asked each of his classmates to choose one restaurant and write down why they chose that restaurant.

The survey results were different from what he had expected. Satoru thought that Le Papillon would be the most popular choice since it is located very close to the station and his classmates can celebrate their graduation by eating at a fancy restaurant. However, more than half of them chose Toscana because they thought the price is not too expensive and it is not too far from the station. Chen's Kitchen is reasonably priced, but some students thought the restaurant was too casual. Hanami was the second most popular choice. Some students wrote that they really like the food there. Others wrote that they thought Japanese food would be suitable for graduation.

Once Satoru finished analyzing the results of his survey, he shared them with his classmates and told everyone that their graduation party would take place at Toscana. The students in his class were happy with the decision and told Satoru that they were looking forward to the graduation party. A group of students volunteered to help Satoru plan the party. They have only three weeks left until they graduate from high school. Satoru and his classmates hope that they can make as many good memories as possible during the rest of their time together.
