Rei is a university student from a small town in the countryside. Last year, he moved to Tokyo to study business at university, but he often misses his hometown. His goal is to become a successful businessperson and help bring life back to small countryside towns.

At university, Rei often talks about his goal with Professor Yamada, his advisor. She encouraged Rei to apply to a business plan competition held by a small city. The city is collecting business ideas for how they can reuse a large 150-year-old traditional Japanese home. Rei decided to enter the competition and asked three of his classmates, who also major in business, to join him.

Their first meeting, however, did not go well. Everyone had their own ideas, and they could not agree on a single one because they did not want to reject the ideas of the other person. After two weeks, they still could not decide on a business plan. Discouraged, Rei went to Professor Yamada for advice. She listened to his story and said, "I think your group's problem is that you are scared to disagree with each other's ideas because you think disagreeing with an idea is the same as disagreeing with the person. It's not."

Rei understood Professor Yamada's advice. The next day, he talked with his group members and asked everyone to share their ideas again. "This time," Rei said, "let's honestly share our opinions. Even if we disagree with someone's idea, it's okay. Not liking someone's idea does not mean that you do not like the person. We are just disagreeing with the idea, not the person."

After listening to Rei, his teammates felt more comfortable expressing their opinions to one another. Five hours later, they finally decided on the first draft of their business plan that included all of their group's best ideas.

For three months, the four of them worked hard every day on their business plan. They passed the first stage of the contest. Three months later, they presented their business plan online, in front of the judges and other participants. Although their team did not win, Rei got something much more valuable. He learned that it is okay to disagree with others' ideas as long as you treat them respectfully. He also got some great ideas to help revive his hometown.
