## Intent of the Program

<Provisional Translation>

- COVID-19 is having a significant economic effect on the lives of students, such as by dramatically reducing household income and also severely lowering or completely wiping out part-time income.
- It is conceivable that students, especially those who do not live at home, may face difficulties continuing their studies at their university or other educational institution.
- We believe nothing is more important than providing proper support to students so that they do not abandon their studies because of COVID-19.

## **Program Overview**

- ◇ People attending universities and other educational institutions in Japan, including international students, are covered by the program.
- ♦ Although recipients must fulfill criteria, such as not living at home and covering tuition with resources such as part-time work, or losing a significant amount of income due to COVID-19 pandemic. (Estimated number : around 430,000 students)
- ♦ Students who are exempt from residence tax will receive 200,000 Japanese yen, while students of other households will receive 100,000 Japanese yen. (Total Budget: around 53.1 billion Japanese yen)
