Background and Developments

With the aim of promoting acceptance of international students who can satisfy needs of Japanese companies and facilitating employment of excellent international students in Japan, while endeavoring to achieve the goal of the plan to accept 300,000 international students, the government of Japan is to establish overseas bases for comprehensively communicating the appeal of studying at Japanese universities: including information on education and research at universities and career paths after graduation, and also establish the headquarters in Japan to support initiatives of those overseas bases. In this manner, the government intends to develop an all-Japan system to support international students, covering the range of activities from student recruitment to follow-ups after their return to their home countries.

Project Outline

■ Overseas bases in 6 areas

The following activities are being carried out in collaboration with local and Japanese related organizations (government organizations, diplomatic missions, educational institutions, companies, etc.) and the headquarters in Japan.

- Collection and communication of information on studying in Japan
- Collect local needs and information on studying in Japan, and provide information meticulously depending on the candidate international students by holding fairs and school visits for introducing Japanese universities and fully utilizing SNSs and networks of former international students who returned to their home countries
- Promotion of activities to recruit excellent international students
- Enhance functions for support for granting admissions locally at respective countries and promote strengthening of learning of academic Japanese locally

○ Creation of networks and deepening of cooperation with former international students who returned to their home countries

Through PR and recruiting activities with cooperation of former international students, provide local students with specific information on studying and living in Japan and job opportunities after graduation in a more effective manner to increase those aspiring to study in Japan

■ Headquarters in Japan

The following activities are being carried out in collaboration with organizations in Japan and overseas bases.

- Collection and analysis of information on trends of international students in areas with overseas bases
- Creation of networks with domestic organizations
- Creation of networks and cooperative relationships with international students residing in Japan
