- Cooperation with study in Japan alumni groups, Nikkei communities and organizations related to higher education institutions.

- Implementation of examinations at São Paulo Office, University of Tsukuba.

### ⑤ Providing Pre-Arrival Orientations and Trainings

- Providing e-learning tools for Japanese language education.
- Cooperating with Japanese alumni association (ASEBEX) on pre-arrival orientation, ‘Koshukai.’

### ⑥ Expanding Recruitment Activities in Spanish Speaking Countries in South America

- Peru, Argentina, Colombia, and Chile.

### ⑦ Cooperating with Japanese Companies on “Study in Japan” Fairs for Introducing Careers

- Cooperating with Chambers of Commerce and Japanese companies in South America.


### ⑧ Cooperating with Other Frameworks of Promotion of Japanese Science and Technology, Higher Education, etc.
