- One of the regional project under “Study in Japan Global Network Project” to familiarize Study in Japan through disseminating attractive aspects of study in Japan and to promote academic linkage among universities in the region and Japan
- Five year project from JFY2018 to JFY2022
- Covers 21 countries in the region

- ✓ Encouraging alumni and alumni association to disseminate their experience in Japan to prospective students




